
I've had over 8 years of experience photographing weddings, portraits, families, and more! I utilize both film and digital




Hello, my name is Kendall Criswell. I live in Griffin, Georgia with my sweet husband and three lovely daughters.


One of my favorite couples prompts is to ask clients to smell each other. I love how they giggle and get all cozy with their significant other.













A Playful Posing Guide For Couples by Rebecca Mabey of Effervescent Media Works

Let's help those wallflowers bloom and loosen up in ways that are natural and fun! In this preview guide, we will go over ways to playfully pose your couples so you can capture unique flirtatous energy and poses that are fluid and fun.

Step 1: Before you even start your session, make an effort to get to know more about your couple and their personalities. I do this through a google form questionairre.

Helping your clients relax

Compliment them and express excitement for their future together.

Tell them your game plan and bring them in on it. Remind them you have a vision.

Let them know that we will be doing some fun things together to capture those in between moments, movements and emotion.

Encourage them to trust you in your art and embrace your techniques as unique as they are.

"Do the wave and shout a cheer for yourself as if you were a sports team!



If you take just about any pose, there is always a oppurtunity to add motion to it. Like a ribbon in the wind. Especially if her hair is down, or she has a fun long dress. Look for what you can move.

EMBRACE THE SILLY

Encourage your clients to loosen up and embrace the

awkwardness, And laugh up the goofy moments that did not meet the standards of Dancing with the Stars. Remind them that you are looking for the emotion and the movement, not



a perfectly planned dance movement. With a lot of busy couples planning their wedding or otherwise, it may have been a while since they hit the dance floor and the left feet show. That is ok! Laugh together and encourage just giving it a try.

BE CHEESY

Come up with those goofy phrases that rythm and get a

surprise laugh

"Face eachother standing 2 feet apart and do a trust fall into him wrapping **VOUT ATMS** around his neck"








PLAY WITH GRAVITY

Start with a starter pose, such as her back against his chest. Then add the movement by having them lock at the hips but swivel the top of their bodies together like a top twirling.

GET INTO THE ACT

Create scenarios that will make the laugh to reeact. Such as "sing the final line of "We are getting married!" as if it were your own musical complete with the dance and final pose. Then bow for the audience. "

"add pep in your step and flip that hair around. Look back and me. And you check her out!"



Put your right arm around her neck and lock the right fingers. Then walk hips

in a zig zag path.."
